

SUMMER CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT

OBJECTIVES: The Day Camp will provide a safe, caring, clean, fun environment for/by both students and staff at all times. Therefore, we have the following expectations:

Each student **MUST** submit an application and current medical before the first day of attendance.

THE CAMP PROMOTES Christian standards, including daily worship and prayers. Each staff and student is required to participate in all routines.

Illicit drugs of any form, or cigarettes should not be used on or around the premises, or at any sponsored function. Users will be expelled.

Obscenities, vulgarities and profanities, expressed in any form, by any one at any time will not be tolerated, and will result in a minimum one-week suspension without refund.

Anyone bringing weapons or dangerous items on the premises will be expelled. Anyone threatening bodily harm or damaging property will be expelled and the authorities will be notified. Immediate suspension or expulsion goes without refund.

NO CHEWING GUM ON PREMISES. Immediate suspension.

Full and immediate cooperation is required of all students at all times. Insubordination is grounds for expulsion.

Mutual respect is expected of students, visitors, staff, and parents during all interaction. No name-calling, teasing, lying, cheating or stealing.

Students and staff must dress discretely: Pants should be loose fitting, worn at waist with belt; no wearing of headphones; no hats are to be worn backward; no du-rags; no cell-phones in class/school.

No body piercing or tattoos. One piercing allowed per ear for girls. Minimal jewelry allowed. Boys are not allowed to wear earrings.

Students may not leave premises without permission until the end of the day's program. After leaving, there is no re-admission.
